WEEK 1

O God, with all our hearts, we long for you.
Come, transform us to be Christ-centred,
Spirit-empowered, Mission-focused people,
multiplying disciples everywhere.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Psalm 42; Psalm 84

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- When was the last time you wept in longing for the presence of God?
- In what ways are you pouring out your soul before God these days? Is your soul downcast because it feels like he is absent or full because he feels present?
- Is dwelling close to God the greatest longing of your soul? Would you trade 1000 days doing something else for a single chance to be with him?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That God would increase the intensity of our longing for him—so much that we would physically feel it.
- That we would do everything we can to be close to his presence.
- That our trust and pursuit of God would be strong even when our souls are downcast, and grief overwhelms us.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, are there any griefs keeping me from dwelling in your presence?
- How do you want to meet me in my grief today?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Kootenays (Cranbrook, Trail, Revelstoke) | Pray for families and individuals in these resource-driven communities who face economic ups and downs, shift work, and seasonal stress.
- Lord, we bring before You the Otomi people of Mexico. Thank You for their rich heritage and resilience through centuries of change. Lord, we pray for their physical and spiritual needs—bless their farms, their work, and their families. We ask that Your truth and love would reach their hearts, breaking through traditions that do not lead to life. Pray for the Jesus followers in the community—that they would be a living example of an Otomi expression of faith. Strengthen those who serve among the Otomi, and let Your light shine in their communities.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Genesis 32:22–32;
Colossians 2:1–3; 4:12

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How could you cultivate more longing for God?
- In what ways does your prayer life reflect a struggle on behalf of others?
- How much wrestling with God are you willing to do to receive his blessing and multiply disciples who are firm in obeying his will?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That we would long for God's blessing as much as Jacob did.
- That we would be relentless in seeking God on behalf of the disciples he has called us to make.
- That we would have perseverance in prayer until he blesses our disciples and us.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, am I longing and wrestling for the right things?
- What do you want me to contend for in prayer until you answer?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Gaspésie (Gaspé, Matane, Rimouski) | Pray for renewed hope in isolated and historic communities, and for small faith gatherings to remain courageous and rooted.
- Lord, we lift up the Huichol people to You. We pray that their hearts be transformed to move from pride in their culture to a love for the Creator and the unique ways He has revealed himself through Wixarika language and culture. In their remote mountains and deep traditions, reveal Your love and truth. Open hearts to the Gospel and raise up workers who will share Christ with compassion and cultural understanding. Bring healing, hope, and peace to their communities.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Psalm 63; Isaiah 55:1–6

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How thirsty are you for God's presence? In what ways has his presence been satisfying your soul?
- How are you enjoying God's love that is better than life?
- What connection might there be between us accepting God's invitation to come to the waters and summoning the nations as those endowed with splendour?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That God would increase our thirst for his presence.
- That we would experience and behold the love, power, and glory of God daily.
- That we would be so endowed with the splendour of Jesus so that the nations would be attracted to God in us.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what good and beautiful gift do you have for me as I seek after you today?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Peace River Region (Peace River, Dawson Creek, Grande Prairie) | Pray for stability and perseverance for leaders and churches serving amid economic fluctuation and transience.
- Lord, we lift up the Turks living in Germany, many of whom came seeking work and opportunity decades ago. Lord, You know their hearts and the cultural ties that make turning to Christ so difficult. We pray for courage for those who are exploring faith in Jesus, that they would find strength and peace in You despite the pressure and shame they may face from family and community. Bless the small fellowships scattered across Germany—encourage them, protect them, and use them as lights in the darkness. May Your Spirit move powerfully among Turkish communities, bringing hope, healing, and salvation to entire households.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Joel 2:12–27; Acts 2:36–41

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- Does your hunger/longing for God lead you to mourn over the sin that keeps you from his presence?
- Do you fast, pray and repent of sin?
- How sensitive is your heart to the conviction of the Spirit?
- How does fasting help you express your longing for God's presence?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That we would immediately recognize when we are out of step with the Spirit and quickly repent.
- That we would be quick to radically repent from the heart, not just with religious words.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, please show me any places where my heart has become insensitive to the conviction of your Spirit.

- Are there any specific ways you call me to show my longing for more of your presence?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Northern Ontario (Timmins, Cochrane, Marathon) | Pray for endurance, deep community relationships, and for the Church's presence to shine brightly across vast and rugged regions.
- Lord, we lift up to You the Moroccan community in Spain and all who leave their homes seeking hope and opportunity. Lord, You know the struggles they face—poverty, exploitation, and the pain of feeling unwelcome. We ask for Your protection over those who are vulnerable, especially women trapped in cycles of abuse. Grant them strength, dignity, and the support they need to flourish. Help nations and communities to show compassion and justice, reflecting Your love for all people. May Your light guide them to safety and peace.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Genesis 3:1–10; Daniel 9:1–19; Phil.4:8

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What do you find to be pleasing to the eye and most desirable these days? Is your greatest longing: All Things Jesus?
- Does your shame cause you to hide from God or pursue him through repentance with fasting and tears?
- How does your longing for the glory of God and his reputation among the nations motivate your prayers?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That 'All Things Jesus' would be the most desirable longing of our lives and that all other longings would pale in comparison.
- That our hearts would be quick to repent to restore intimacy with God rather than to hide in shame.
- That we would humbly plead with God for his forgiveness and that he would use us to reveal his name to the nations.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, in what ways have the eyes of my heart drifted to desire other things more than you?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Toronto (Mississauga, Brampton, Scarborough) | Pray for gospel imagination in diversity. (Immigrant-led communities)
- Lord, we lift up the Basque people to You. Thank You for their rich history, resilience, and unique culture that has endured for centuries. Lord, we pray for spiritual awakening among them, that hearts would turn to You and find hope in Christ. With only a small number of believers among millions, we ask that Your light would shine brightly in the Basque Country. Bless those who labour to share the Gospel there, and may Your Spirit move powerfully to bring peace, unity, and salvation.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Isaiah 60:1–5; Ephesians 5:1–20

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- Is your greatest longing for the glory of the Lord to rise upon you and to light up our world? What difference will it make for you when he satisfies that longing?
- Is there any hint of immorality or greed in your life? Any darkness?
- What earthly longings do you need to release to create more space to long for God?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That God would awaken our hearts with deep longing and ravenous hunger for more of him.
- That our hearts would be filled with joy as the glory of God descends upon us.
- That all dark desires would be banished from our hearts and that we would wholeheartedly long for the beauty of God.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, are there any self-centred longings that need to die and be replaced with Christ-centred ones?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Montréal (Laval, Longueuil, Montréal-Nord) | Pray for courage in post-Christian space. (Francophone expressions)
- Lord, we lift up the Pashtun people living in the Middle East. You know their hearts, their love for family, their rich traditions, and their generous hospitality. We pray that Your light would break through the resistance and hostility toward the Gospel. Strengthen and protect the few believers among them and raise up workers who will share Your Word with courage and compassion. We ask that You transform communities and bring hope where there is darkness.

WEEK 2

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CALGARY, ALBERTA

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Nehemiah 2:11–18

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How open is your heart to the coming of God and his Kingdom? Is there any part of you that is not ready to invite his presence?
- How might the Lord want you to pray, and where might he want you to step into someone's story?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That the Spirit would show you where he wants you to intercede for your family, your church, and our country.
- Invite God into the brokenness that he's identified to you to do the redeeming, restoring work only he can do. Invite him to be more present in your thoughts and choices today so you can be more present to others.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, how do you want to come into my story? How do you want to use me to bring your presence into the story of someone else?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Vancouver (Surrey, Burnaby, Richmond) | Pray for hope amid loneliness. (Missional communities)
- Lord, we lift up the Azerbaijani people to You. Lord, You know their history—from Zoroastrian roots to a brief Christian heritage now overshadowed by Islam. We pray for hearts to be opened to the truth of Jesus Christ. Strengthen the few believers among the Azerbaijani and empower them to shine Your light boldly. In a culture that values loyalty and hospitality, may Your love be revealed through relationships and conversations.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- 2 Samuel 6:12–23; 2 Timothy 4:6–8

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How are you inviting the presence of God to come daily in your life and ministry?
- How are you fighting the good fight in such a way that shows your longing for his appearance?
- Does the joy of God's presence cause you to celebrate?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That we would sacrifice whatever it takes not to hinder the presence of God from dwelling among us.
- That our longing for the Coming King to appear would compel us to sacrificial action on behalf of others.
- That we would pour out our lives to prepare the nations, including the Tajik, for his coming.
- That we would regularly experience his coming among us in such a way that would fill us with great joy.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, are there any sacrifices you are calling me to make to prepare the way for your coming?
- What is one step that you are calling me to take today?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Calgary (Airdrie, Okotoks, Chestermere) | Pray for resilience through transition. (Suburban initiatives)
- Lord, we lift-up the 321,000 Uyghurs in Kazakhstan, most of whom do not know You. Open doors for authentic relationships and raise up workers willing to patiently share the gospel. Thank You for the six Uyghur fellowships—strengthen and encourage them and give them boldness to share Your love. Amid cultural and political pressures, let Your Spirit move powerfully and draw many to Yourself.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Ezekiel 37:1–14; John 20:19–23

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What are the dry bones in your life, or church, that need a fresh visitation of the breath of the Spirit? What might your role be in prophesying to the breath?
- Are there places of fear in your life that need to experience the peace of Jesus?
- Who might Jesus be sending you as the Father sent him?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That the presence of Jesus would bring us great peace, even when we face fearful circumstances.
- Pray for the breath of the Spirit to fill those who are discouraged and whose hope is gone.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, how are you calling me to bring your transformational breath of healing to the world?
- What hope do you have for me in my brokenness?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- 9. Edmonton (St. Albert, Leduc, Sherwood Park) | Pray for unity across cultures. (Neighbourhood-based ventures)
- Lord, We lift up the 60 million Gulf Arabs, You know their hearts, their history, and the deep roots of their culture. Lord, we pray for those few who follow Jesus—strengthen them with courage and surround them with Your protection. For those who have yet to hear Your name, open doors for the Gospel to be shared in love and wisdom. We ask for peace and understanding in a region where professing faith in Christ can cost family, honour, livelihood, or even life. May Your Spirit move powerfully, bringing hope and truth to hearts that seek You. We pray that entire households will come to faith, experiencing Your grace together and becoming lights in their communities.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Exodus 33:12–23; Acts 4:23–31

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How are you seeking after the presence of God to empower you for the mission he has given you?
- How does God's presence in you distinguish you from others?
- Are you desperate for God to show you his glory, to stretch out his hand to heal, and to enable you to speak his Word boldly? Do you ask for this regularly?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That the places where we meet for prayer would be shaken with God's presence.
- That we would all be filled with the Holy Spirit and enabled to speak the Word of God boldly.
- That we would never go anywhere without the presence of God leading the way.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, are there ways I have been settling for less than the fullness of your Holy Spirit in my life?
- How can I cultivate a greater longing for your presence?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Winnipeg (Selkirk, Steinbach, East St. Paul) | Pray for healing and reconciliation. (Community-rooted leadership)
- Lord, we lift up the people of Tajikistan. Lord, You know their history of hardship and resilience through centuries of invasions and change. We pray for peace and stability in their land and for provision for farmers and shepherds who depend on the earth for their livelihood. Bless their communities with hope and opportunity, and let Your light shine in the valleys and cities alike. We ask that hearts be opened to Your truth and that those who follow Jesus would be strengthened and encouraged. May Your Word take root in this land, and may entire families come to know Your love and grace.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- 2 Chronicles 20:1–22;
2 Kings 19:14–19, 35–37

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- Are there battles you face alone that you need to invite God to fight for you?
- Is there anything you need to ask the Lord for his divine intervention?
- When you feel overwhelmed by challenges—or waiting for God to answer prayer—are you quick to worship or fear?
- How might those challenges be an invitation to trust?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That our first instinct when trouble strikes would be to humble ourselves and cry out for God’s intervention.
- That God would use impossible situations to grow our faith and reveal his glory to us and the world.
- That God would come and deliver us from everything that seeks to steal our joy and our effectiveness in extending the Kingdom of God.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what divine solution do you want me to trust you for in prayer today confidently?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Nova Scotia & Prince Edward Island (Halifax, Dartmouth, Bedford, Truro, Sydney, Charlottetown, Summerside) | Pray for students, young adults, and transient populations—that churches would become steady homes of belonging and new faith. Pray for creativity and courage in smaller coastal and rural communities holding faithful witness.
- Lord, we lift up the people of Turkey, a nation rich in history yet spiritually in need of Your truth. Lord, You know the complexities of this place. We pray for hearts to be open to the Gospel and for courage among the few believers to share Your love boldly. Break down barriers of fear and misunderstanding, and let Your light shine in homes, communities, and cities. May Your Spirit move powerfully, bringing hope and salvation to entire households and restoring the heritage of faith in this land.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- 2 Chron. 7:1–16; Exodus 19:9–19; 1 John 3:1–3

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How might God be calling you to prepare yourself for a fresh visitation of his presence?
- Are there any unconsecrated areas of your life that the Spirit is prompting you to surrender to him so that you can be pure as he is pure?
- How willing are you for the extraordinary glory of God to interrupt your plans?
- Do you long for his visitation?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That all of us would humble ourselves, pray, seek his face, and turn from our wicked ways so that God would forgive our sins and heal our land.
- That our longing and hope for his coming would compel us to purify ourselves to be like him and prepare.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, is anything hindering the full glory of your presence from filling my life and church?
- How can I prepare the way for your presence?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- New Brunswick & Newfoundland and Labrador | (Saint John, Moncton, Fredericton, Bathurst, St. John's) Pray for perseverance for people serving in regions marked by distance, decline, and migration. Pray for relational faith to flourish where communities are scattered and spiritual hunger is quiet but deep.
- Lord, we lift up the Pashtun people—40 to 45 million in Afghanistan and Pakistan. We pray for courage and wisdom for those sharing the Gospel. Strengthen the few believers and raise up a vibrant, indigenous disciple-making movement that will bring hope and transformation. Open hearts to Your Word and let Your peace reign despite fear and conflict. May Your love break through every stronghold and bring entire families to faith in Jesus.

WEEK 3

O God, with all our hearts, we long for you.
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SASKATOON, SASKATCHEWAN

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BIBLE READINGS:

- 2 Corinthians 3:3–18; Philippians 1:6; Ephesians 3:20–21

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How is praying “come transform us” similar to the Lord’s Prayer, “your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven”?
- In what ways has your relationship with Jesus changed your life?
- When you pray for yourself and your church, how do you exhibit faith, hope, and imagination?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That we would be grateful for all that Jesus has done in our lives and churches.
- That our gratitude for the past transformation we’ve experienced would fuel the desire for ongoing growth into the image of Jesus.
- That we would pursue the change that Jesus has in store for us, even that which can only come through loss, hardship, challenge, and sorrow.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what MORE do you have in mind for me, my church, and The Alliance Canada?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Whitehorse (Dawson City, Carcross | Pray for endurance and trust. (Contextual discipleship)
- Lord, we lift up the people of Japan to You with gratitude for their rich culture, deep traditions, and strong sense of community and perseverance. We pray that Your peace and hope would be known throughout the nation, especially among those who feel pressure, isolation, or quiet spiritual longing. Strengthen and encourage the small Christian community in Japan, giving believers wisdom, humility, and courage to reflect Your love in their relationships and daily lives. Bless pastors and churches as they serve faithfully, often in hidden and challenging circumstances. May many come to experience the grace, forgiveness, and new life found in Jesus Christ.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Romans 12:1–2; 1 Corinthians 2:6–16

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What patterns of the world are most tempting for you to conform to?
- In what ways does Christ change your perspective on these worldly patterns?
- What might it look like for you to be transformed by renewing your mind so that you become Christ-centred in your thinking?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That we would be transformed by the hope of what God has prepared for those who love him, and that he would reveal this hope to us by his Spirit.
- That all our thinking would be aligned with Christ.
- That the patterns of the world would no longer entice us, but instead, we would be captivated by the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what is one way that my mind still needs to be renewed and transformed so that it aligns with Yours?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Yellowknife (Dettah, Ndilq) | Pray for leaders in complex realities. (Partnership-first approaches)
- Lord, we ask you to turn the Min Nan people's hearts toward you. Heal their spiritual eyes, so they may see you and turn and be healed. Help them know that you are king of all kings and that you rule in the spiritual world, so they do not need to be afraid of other spirits. Break the spiritual bondage the enemy has kept them in so that they can be truly free. Help them to know what it means to be true children of the living God.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Genesis 28:10–22; 33:1–11; 35:1–3; 49:1–10

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- As you reflect on the transformation of Jacob, from one who stole the blessing to one who blessed his sons and the nations, what strikes you?
- What has been your journey of transformation? What chapters do you still long for God to write?
- Are there any broken relationships that you need God to transform? What is your role?
- How do you still need to be transformed so that you can pass on a blessing to your family and the world?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That we would all have encounters with God like Jacob.
- That God would transform our perspective so that we can see his face where we would least expect it.

- That God would go before us into our broken relationships to make reconciliation possible.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what is the next step you have for me in my transformation journey?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Thompson (Meadowlake, Flin Flon | Pray for wisdom as a northern regional hub. (smaller communities covering vast geography)
- Lord, we lift up the Vietnamese people living in Cambodia. You see their struggles—poverty, illiteracy, and the challenges of being undocumented in an unwelcoming society. Lord, draw near to the broken-hearted and provide hope where there is despair. We pray for the young generation, that they would encounter Your truth and love. Strengthen the small number of believers and the growing church presence in Phnom Penh and raise up workers to bring the Gospel to regions where there is no access. May Your light shine in the darkness and transform lives for Your glory.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Genesis 37:12–20; 41:1–16, 33–40; 45:1–11

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- As you reflect on the transformation of Joseph, what strikes you?
- Are there points of similarity between your journey of transformation and Joseph's journey?
- What are the dreams you are still waiting for God to fulfill? Can you see ways that God is transforming you in the process of waiting?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That God would redeem the suffering in our lives to bring about the fulfillment of his dreams for us.
- That God's transforming work in us would have a transforming impact that brings blessing to the world.
- That our hearts would be transformed so thoroughly that we could forgive those who have hurt us deeply.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, how are you currently at work transforming me to prepare me for the fulfillment of your purposes?
- How can I partner with you in this transformation?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Sudbury (Nickel Belt communities) | Pray for renewal beyond industry and for churches helping rebuild community identity and hope.
- Lord, we lift up the Khalka Mongol people to You. Thank You for their rich heritage and deep connection to the land. We pray for Your peace and blessing over their nomadic communities. Lord, open hearts to Your truth and reveal Your love to them in ways they can understand. Break down spiritual barriers and bring light where there is darkness. May Your glory fill the steppes of Mongolia and transform lives for Your kingdom.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- 2 Samuel 24:1–25; Psalm 51:1–6; Matthew 3:8

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How might God want to redeem your sins to transform you more into someone after his heart?
- Does the way you deal with your sin demonstrate deep repentance? Does your repentance cost you something, or is it just words?
- What fruit do you observe of the transformation in your life in how you respond after you have sinned? Do you quickly sense the conviction of the Spirit?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That our consciences would be sensitive to the conviction of the Spirit when we have sinned.
- That we would be willing to assume the consequences of our sin and not try to hide or defer blame to others.

- That our desire to be in the right relationship with God and one another would compel us to make restitution for the wrongs we have committed.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, is there any hidden sin that you want to expose as part of your ongoing transformation in my heart?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Fort McMurray (Regional work camps) | Pray for families and leaders navigating mobility and transience—for flexible, relational expressions of church.
- Lord, we lift up the Tibetan people to You. Lord, we pray for Your light to shine in the mountains and valleys of Tibet and in the hearts of its people. Strengthen the few believers and the small fellowships—encourage them, protect them, and use them as instruments of Your love. Open doors for the Gospel to be shared with grace and wisdom. May those who come to know You grow into strong leaders who bring Christ to their communities. Lord, let Your peace and presence transform lives.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- John 17:20–26; 1 Cor. 1:10–17; John 13:35

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What would it look like for you to join in the prayer of Jesus for unity among believers? How is this prayer an expression of God's love?
- How will our ongoing transformation into Christ-centred people lead us into greater humility and enable us to live in unity with others?
- How will our love for one another reveal Jesus to all?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That the Body of Christ would be brought to complete unity to let the world know that the Father has sent Jesus because of his love for them.
- That the love of God would transform us to be so Christ-centred that we can love others no matter what.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, how are you inviting me to join in your prayer for unity among your people?
- How can I be part of the answer to your prayer

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Prince George (Quesnel, Vanderhoof) | Pray for strengthened leadership across vast regions and for multiplication of healthy, place-rooted leaders. Pray for those involved in the Forestry and Sawmill industries.
- Lord, we lift up India before You—a land of immense diversity, rich history, and great spiritual need. With over 1.48 billion people and thousands of unreached groups, Lord, we ask that Your light would shine in every corner. Break through barriers of tradition, caste, and false gods, and draw hearts to the living and true God. We pray for those bound by the caste system, for the marginalized and oppressed, that they would find dignity and hope in Christ. Raise up workers who will share the Gospel with compassion and cultural understanding.

BIBLE READINGS:

- Colossians 1:15–23; Revelation 21:1–7

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- In what ways am I prone to short-change the person and ministry of Jesus? In my life? In the lives of others?
- Why might I take comfort in a diminished view of who Jesus is and what he has done?
- How might I better understand and commit to Jesus to change or expand my ministry or the ministry of others?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That God would show you the practical implications of what a grander understanding of who Jesus is would mean for life and ministry.
- That you would have a constantly growing desire to know and to love Jesus more deeply.
- That God would give you an increased desire to share with others who Jesus is in his fullness.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what have I forgotten, overlooked, or not yet realized about who you are that you want me to discover or remember?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Fort St. John (Oil, gas, and energy belt) | Pray for integrity, safety, and wisdom among industry leaders and workers. Ask God to bring stability in seasons of economic fluctuation. Pray for families affected by shift work, layoffs, and the pressures of a resource-based economy.
- We bring the Sasak people of Indonesia before You. You know their struggles—poverty, natural disasters, and fragile family life. Comfort those who are hurting and provide healing for those traumatized by hardship. Lord, strengthen families and bring peace to their homes. We pray for protection from disasters, and for improved health and care for mothers and children. We ask that Your love and truth would reach the Sasak people. Encourage the few believers among them and give them courage to share Your hope. May Your light shine in their communities and transform hearts for Your glory.

- Are you living rooted in your identity of Christ?

- That we would choose light instead of darkness and gratitude instead of complaining.

Comfort those who are hurting and provide healing for those traumatized by hardship. Lord, strengthen families and bring peace and stability to their homes. We pray for protection from earthquakes and floods, and for improved health and care for mothers and children. We ask that Your love and truth would reach the Sasak people. Encourage the few believers among them and give them courage to share Your hope. May Your light shine in their communities and transform hearts for Your glory.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- John 13:1–17; Colossians 3:1–17

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- To what extent would you identify with Paul’s statement that “Christ is your life”? How does your life reflect the servant heart of Jesus?
- Are there things at the centre of your life that you need to put to death so that Christ can be the centre?
- How can you clothe yourself with Christ so that the image of the Creator is more clearly reflected in you?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That our longing to be All Things Jesus would give us the courage to put everything contrary to death.
- That the compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, forgiveness, and love of Jesus would be the very centre of how we live as his people.
- That we would follow the example of Jesus in washing the feet of all.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, which of your character traits do you want me to focus on putting on today? How can I do that?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- What is the most significant evidence that you are a new creation with Christ at the centre of your life?
- How does Christ's love compel you?
- How is Christ empowering you as an ambassador of reconciliation in the world?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That the Spirit would move us to embrace God's very best plan for our lives.
- That our new nature as those in whom Christ dwells would shine brightly for all to see his beauty in us.
- That the love of Jesus would compel us to multiply disciples who experience Jesus as we do.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what are the new things you have birthed in my life through your indwelling presence? Is there any old that is still vying to take centre place?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- La Ronge (Air Ronge, northern communities) | Pray for healing, hope, and patient listening as leaders discern Jesus' work in Indigenous contexts.
- Lord, we pray for the monks, leaders, and families who guide village life among the Laotian. May Your love reach them and Your Spirit open their hearts to the hope in Christ. Strengthen the faith of the believers, encourage their witness, and protect them from discouragement. May they shine as lights in their villages, sharing Your grace with humility and courage.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Luke 23:26–43; Philippians 2:1–18

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- As you read the account of his crucifixion, what is striking to you about Jesus' attitude?
- How is this same attitude at work in your life?
- Is there any way that Jesus is calling you to consider others better than yourself?
- How might God be inviting you to lean into your identity as a child of God?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That our hearts would care for others and offer them forgiveness, even when they treat us poorly.
- That we would look to the interests of others.
- That the Church would shine like stars in the universe because Jesus is at the centre.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, how are you inviting me to work out my salvation so that you are at the centre of everything?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- The Pas (Opaskwayak Cree Nation) | Pray for shared leadership across cultures and for discipleship rooted deeply in community and place.
- Lord, we lift up the Rohingya people to You. You see their suffering, displacement, and pain. Comfort those who have lost homes and loved ones and provide for their daily needs in refugee camps. Lord, bring justice and peace where there is violence and persecution. Protect the vulnerable and give strength to those who feel forgotten. We pray for the small number of believers among the Rohingya—encourage them, sustain them, and let their light shine in the darkness. May Your love and truth bring hope and healing to this hurting community.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Ephesians 1:15–23; Philippians 3:7–21

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How is the incomparably great power of Christ central to all you do?
- In what ways is Jesus the head over everything in your church? What does this look like in practical terms?
- Is your desire to live a life that is “All Things Jesus” the one thing you strive for? Would you consider everything that is not Christ-centred to be rubbish?
- How is your heavenly citizenship central to the way you live today?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That God would give us his Spirit of wisdom and revelation so that we know him better.
- That the power which raised Christ from the dead would transform the way we live as his people.
- That we would know the joy of a Christ-centred life, knowing him in his power and sharing in his sufferings.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, are there things I need to leave behind so that I can strive after a fully Christ-centred life?

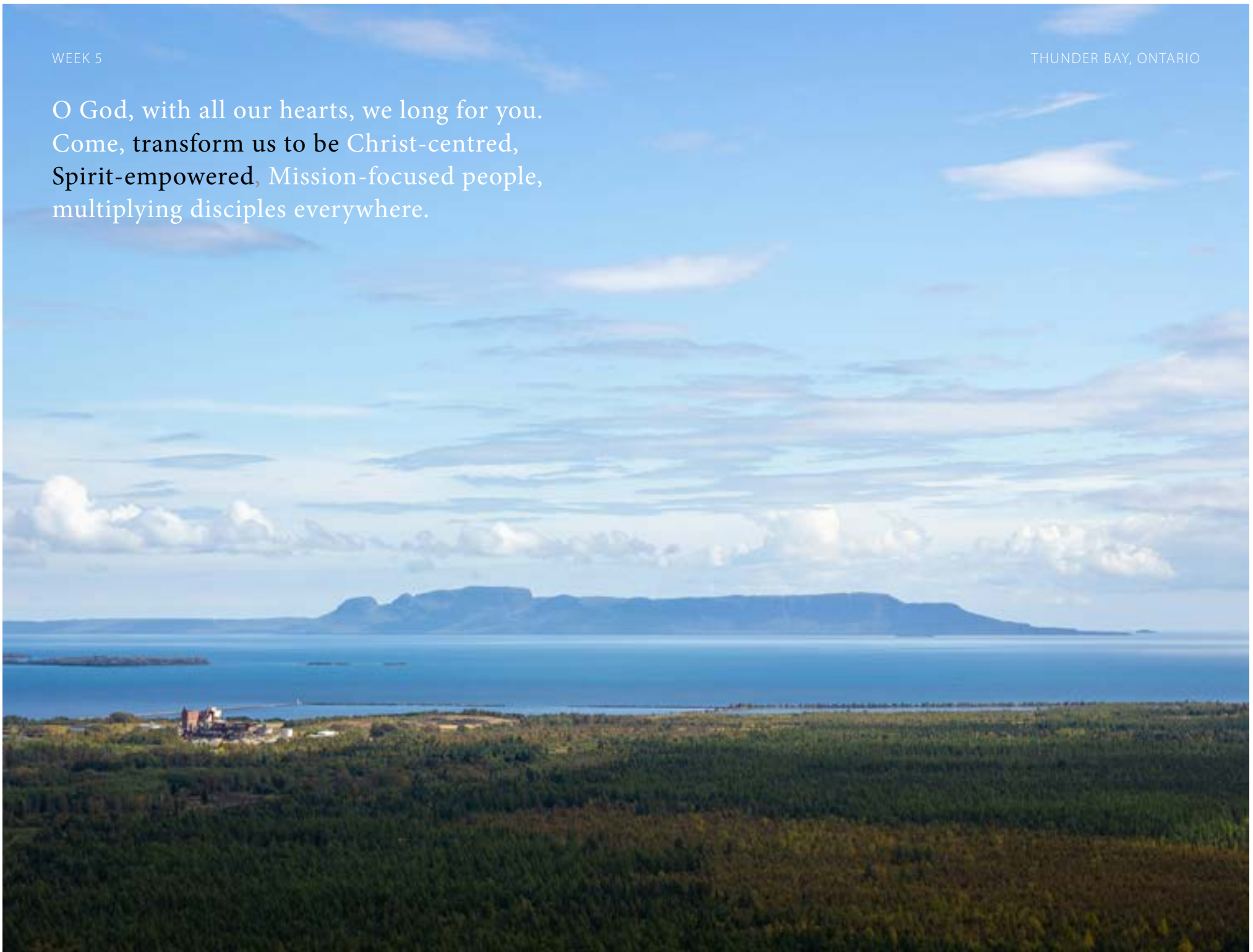
MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- How have you experienced the Spirit strengthening you in obedience? Where do you sense his invitation to be conformed to Christ?
- Where do you sense a need for the Spirit to empower your ministry?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That you, your loved ones, your church, and your city would experience the love of God; be empowered by the Spirit to walk in holiness and participate in the ministry of Jesus.

We ask for Your Spirit to move powerfully in this land, breaking down barriers and bringing hope where fear and tradition prevail.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Joel 2:21–32; Acts 2:1–21

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- Are there areas in your life where God says: “Be not afraid because my Spirit is with you”?
- Are you expectant for the Spirit to be poured out on you and your church family in transformational ways?
- How is the Spirit’s work among the young and old in your church?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That we would have great boldness through the Spirit to not be afraid to declare the wonders of God.
- That all of us would be filled with the Holy Spirit and be anointed with the gifts we need to bring salvation to all the people groups living around us.
- That the presence of the Spirit in our lives would be unexplainable and irresistibly attractive to the world.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what wonders do you want to release in my life through your Spirit’s work in and through me?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- London (Guelph, Waterloo) | Pray for spiritual curiosity and bold, student-led expressions of Jesus-centered community.
- Lord, we lift up the Sudanese people who have endured years of war and hardship. Comfort refugees and those still living in fear. Provide food, shelter, and safety, and surround them with Your peace. We pray for Sudanese Arabs, devoted to their faith yet longing for hope. Reveal Your saving love through Jesus Christ and open hearts to Your grace. Strengthen the few believers to be bold and compassionate witnesses of Your truth.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Exodus 17:8–16; 1 Sam. 12:23; Romans 8:26–27

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How have you experienced the Spirit helping you with your prayers through intercession?
- What battles are you fighting in prayer that you can only win with the help of the Spirit?
- How could the Spirit help you persevere in prayer for others, even when the people you pray for are unresponsive?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That God would give you the perseverance to keep praying until he gives you the victories he has called you to fight for.
- That God would raise intercessors to hold up your hands when you are tempted to give up—and that he would help you to do the same for others.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, is there a battle you are calling me to fight for in prayer with the help of the Holy Spirit and others in my community of faith?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Sherbrooke (Eastern Townships | Pray for gospel imagination to grow in French contexts and for emerging French-language leaders.
- Lord, we lift up the Yemeni people displaced by war. Provide for their needs and open doors for education and work. Reveal Your love through Jesus Christ and bring hope where there is despair. Strengthen believers and raise up compassionate hearts to serve. Amen.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- How has the Spirit gifted you for works of service to God's people?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That we would all be completely humble and patient to experience the unity that the Spirit brings.
- That our complaining would be transformed into Spirit-empowered solutions to the challenges we face.
- That God would raise Spirit-empowered believers to partner with us in his Kingdom work.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what do I most need Spirit-empowerment for today? To be humble or patient? To equip others for the work of the Kingdom? To trust and not complain?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Lethbridge (Coaldale · Fort Macleod) | Pray for regional leadership to flourish and for shared city–rural ministry models.

- How are you personally partnering with the ambition God has given The Alliance to preach the Gospel where Christ is not known?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That our hearts would be tender and compassionate towards those far from Christ.
- That the fruit of our mission would be much rejoicing in heaven over the many sinners who repent.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, how can I join you in your careful search of those you are pursuing?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Let us join the early Church in praying, "Maranatha, Come Lord Jesus!"

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what are you saying to the Church and me today in the specific area of disciple-making?
- How can I join you in this mission today?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Brandon | Pray for endurance and gospel presence in prairie cities that quietly serve vast rural and farming regions.
- Pray for The Alliance's growth driver: prayer. We're forming prayer groups, intercession teams, and "prayer shields." Pray for expectancy for divine encounter, increased corporate prayer and pursuit of God's presence and for a new generation of prayer warriors to rise up.

O God, with all our hearts,
we long for you. Come,
transform us to be Christ-

multiplying disciples

BIBLE READINGS:

- Matthew 28:16–20; John 20:19–23

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How does the authority given to Christ give you courage for the work of making disciples?
- How would you teach a new disciple to obey what Jesus commanded?
- Who is Jesus sending you to? Have you received the filling of the Spirit to be empowered for the task? Ask for this gift today!

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That all our efforts to multiply disciples locally and globally would be anointed with the authority and presence of Christ.
- That our disciple-making would be transformational.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, how can I bring your presence and authority into everything I do to multiply disciples?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- The Battlefords (North Battleford, Battleford) | Pray for unity, reconciliation, and steady leadership in communities carrying deep history and cultural diversity.
- Pray for The Alliance's growth driver: leaders. As a movement, we want to raise up 3,000 new pastors. Pray for people of all walks of life to feel a sense of calling from Jesus. Pray that new leaders would feel Jesus' invitation on their life, that he would provide the means to pursue vocational ministry, and that they would have the courage to join Jesus in his mission.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Acts 20:17–24; 1 Corinthians 9:19–27

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What most strikes you about Paul's efforts to multiply disciples everywhere?
- Paul was "all in" when it came to disciple-making. What would "all in" look like for you?
- How could you leave your comfort zone to make the Gospel relevant to those God has called you to reach?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That we would pursue all possible means to multiply disciples and have the courage to do all we can to provide access to Jesus for all people.
- That we would be compelled to complete the missional tasks that Jesus has given us and that we would do so with great humility and heartfelt tears.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what is one way I could identify with those you call me so that I might make an impact?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Bruce Region (Midland, Owen Sound) | Pray for faithful leadership and creative, year-round ministry presence in communities shaped by both rural life and seasonal rhythms.
- Kelowna (West Kelowna, Vernon) | Pray for intergenerational purpose and spiritually mature communities that invest in mentoring younger leaders.
- Pray for The Alliance's growth driver: ministries. Pray for New Ventures; that new churches, new sites, new partnerships, and new congregations would be planted all in places that are least-church and under-resourced. Pray for creativity and courage as people discover and discern the new things that God is doing in Canada.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Genesis 41:14–16/25–40; 1 Peter 2:9–12

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- Why did Pharaoh extend such favour to Joseph? How did the quality of his life among the pagans lead to the salvation of the nations?
- How might you gain favour with those you connect with? How could this help you to multiply disciples?
- What distinguishes you in the eyes of the unbelievers around you?
- How does your life declare the praises of God in a way that is attractive to others?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That God would raise wise and discerning leaders to faithfully represent Christ in positions of influence in our country and world.
- That the strength, beauty, and wisdom of our lives would have a transformational impact on the lives of others, leading many to become disciples of Jesus.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, what is one way that I can best reflect your wisdom and beauty to those I connect with today?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Kamloops Region & Nanaimo | Pray for church and community leadership and civic wisdom
- Capital Region (Ottawa · Gatineau) | Pray for spiritual openness in government and professional centres, and for churches engaging leaders who shape national life.
- Pray for The Alliance's growth driver: ministries. Pray for existing churches. Pray that our collective cultures of prayer and missional engagement would grow. Pray for healthy leaders that reflect Christ and his kingdom. Pray that God would continue to strengthen and grow local churches across Canada.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Zechariah 8:20–23; Acts 17:16–34

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How did Paul respond to the distressing reality he encountered in Athens? How could we respond in similar ways to anything that opposes Christ?
- What are ways to make the Gospel relevant and attractive today without losing the truth?
- One day, people from all nations will say: “Let us go with you because we have heard that God is with you.” Do our lives reflect the beauty of Emmanuel in such a way that others would want to join us in being his disciples?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That Christ in us would shine brightly for all to see—and that many would long to join us as his disciples.
- That we would have the wisdom to reveal the unchanging truth and beauty of Jesus in ways that our changing world can understand and appreciate.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, is there anything in my life that is hindering me from reflecting your presence to those around me?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Resort Communities (Canmore, Revelstoke, Whistler) | Pray for stability where populations fluctuate and for creative ministries that reach workers and visitors alike.
- Muskoka (Bracebridge · Huntsville) | Pray for faithful, year-round witness in seasonal towns and for flexible, portable expressions of church.
- Pray for our growth driver: Stewardship and Effectiveness. Pray creativity with land and property and how churches can use their spaces to meet the needs of their neighbours and bring glory to Christ. Pray for creativity to develop more integrated tools and systems so that more resources can be used to proclaim the name and fame of Jesus. Pray for Safe Ministries: for wisdom, that trauma and conflict would be resolved, and that injustices would be made right.

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BIBLE READINGS:

- Daniel 2:24–30; 3:13–30; 4:34–37

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- How did Daniel and his friends have a transformational impact on the pagan nation of Babylon? How did their faithful witness to Nebuchadnezzar have a multiplicative effect on all the countries in the empire?
- In an increasingly post-Christendom society, how might we have this kind of transformative impact for Christ and multiply disciples everywhere?

PERSONAL PRAYER:

- That we would have the courage to follow Christ even when this brings hostility from others boldly, and that we would have the wisdom to do so in ways that humbly and beautifully reflect the character of Jesus.
- That the power of Christ in us would deliver us from evil and convince many to join us in being his disciples.

LISTENING PRAYER:

- Jesus, how can I multiply disciples everywhere?
- What is the unique role you are calling me to play?

MISSIONAL PRAYER:

- Southern Saskatchewan (Swift Current, Weyburn) | Pray for perseverance among churches and bi-vocational leaders serving rural and farming regions.
- Canada | Pray for unity, courage, and obedience. (Discernment → partnership → response)
- Pray for your church! Pray for a fresh outpouring of the Spirit, that Jesus would continue to move in your local community. Pray for your pastor, your elders, and church leadership. Pray that God would transform your community—on earth as it is in heaven.
